ORDINANCE NO. 8167

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RITTMAN, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTIES AND STATE OF OHIO, PROVIDING EMERGENCY AUTHORITY FOR THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO RESTRICT AND CLOSE PUBLIC AREAS.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Rittman, Counties of Wayne and Medina and State of Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected and appointed thereto concurring:

SECTION ONE.

Any city property or public area may be declared closed to the public by the Municipal Manager at any time and for any interval of time, either temporarily or at regular or stated intervals. The Manager may delegate her authority under this section to any employee of the Department of Parks and Recreation or any police officer of the city.

SECTION TWO.

No person shall refuse to leave, fail to leave, or re-enter, any city property or public area after such person has been notified by the Municipal Manager or by any police officer of the city that such property or area has been closed. Whoever violates this division is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree.

SECTION THREE.

For the purposes of this ordinance, “city property or public area” shall include, but is not limited to: all parks and playgrounds, roads and highways, sidewalks, and all buildings, grounds and other real property owned by the City.

SECTION FOUR.

This authority is specifically intended to be temporary and shall be automatically revoked on April 31, 2020 unless extended by a majority of Council by motion at a public meeting.

SECTION FIVE.

Due to the potential spread of COVIT-19 through person to person transmission on city property or public areas, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, and safety and shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage.
